b. Website/Social Media/Email –We currently have 832 followers on Twitter (+40 from last year). We have 3841 "Likes" on our Facebook page (+369 from last year). We have started using Hootsuite to make it easier to post info to both social media platforms. We utilized Constant Contact a lot this season to keep our club directors informed about the COVID-19 crisis and resources available to them. We will be moving to a new database hosted by SportsEngine this fall. There should be some improved communication tools that come out of that system that should help us promote our messages better.

- c. Tournaments For the first time in a couple seasons, we did not have inclement weather cancel a whole weekend of events. However, the global COVID-19 pandemic did cause us to cancel our final regular season weekend of events and our Regional Championships. It has also caused us to cancel the first three months of the beach season. We had 3188 total entries for one-day sanctioned events.
- d. Regional Championship Results Regional Championships were cancelled due to COVID-19. 540 teams were scheduled to participate (84% of those that had qualified for Regionals). All entry fees were refunded within 2 weeks of the cancellation notice.

## e. Coaching Program:

• We did not hold any in-person IMPACT clinics this season. The course is offered free and online by USAV. They are in discussions to require all future IMPACT courses to be taken online so everyone is getting same content and message. So, we will plan on just referring everyone to the online course in the future. 446 Coaches took the IMPACT course this season.

# f. Officials Program:

- We amended the in-person clinics this year. Larger clubs were limited to having a clinic only for the 14-and-under age groups. All ages 15 and older were directed to take the clinic online. This seemed to help us in scheduling the in-person clinics as there was less demand for clinicians.
- O USAV is moving to a new Learning Management System for next season. We are hopeful that will improve the user experience and have less technical issues during the high demand periods. They are also coming out with new clinic options for juniors. We will evaluate these options to hopefully be able to move more users to the online clinic option.
- We certified 9050 (8844 last year) referees through online and in-person clinics this season.
- The Officials Accelerated Advancement Program continued to train interested professional officials at a high level. We currently have 20 officials in the program.
- O The pandemic impacted several of our officials in the pipeline to receive a National rating. Joey Asis was accepted to go for his National rating. He will automatically be accepted next year. We also felt we had a good shot at getting three referees accepted for their Junior National rating. USAV is looking at having expanded numbers of candidates next year so they don't fall behind in numbers.
- g. Summary 2020 was looking to be an outstanding membership season. The pandemic did have a big impact on the close of our indoor season and on the entire beach season. There are many discussions ongoing at a national level on the impact going forward. The region needs to be prepared for reduced membership in the near future as people become adjusted to changes in behavior due to the virus. The region does have solid financial reserves to meet short-term challenges. Our hope is that we will all be back on the courts soon enjoying our great sport.

### B. National State of the Game:

• The COVID-19 crisis has impacted the USAV budget in a huge way. The cancellation of the indoor Championships will have a big impact on their revenue this year. They have instituted many cost-cutting measures, and we are still waiting to see what the result will be for USAV staff.

### IV. Meritorious Service Awards:
