- b. Website/Social Media/Email –We currently have 542 followers on Twitter (+104 from last year). We have 2414 "Likes" on our Facebook page (+451 from last year). We continued to use Constant Contact this year to keep our clubs and members more informed during the season. With every email we sent, we promoted our Social Media platforms, especially our Facebook page. We will do some special giveaways again to lucky followers when we hit 2500 Likes! Our Social Media platforms continue to be a great way to keep the membership informed and involved in Carolina Region updates.
- c. Tournaments We had one tournament weekend affected by inclement weather, but overall, it was a very smooth year. The number of overall complaints has reduced drastically with our current formats and processes. The move to Sunday tournaments on most weekends really helped us with both courts and officials. We will be proposing having a Sunday option on all weekends now. Our Technology Committee updated the Points System with a new look and improved functionality. We still have many more items on our wish list that we hope to roll out before next season.
- d. Regional Championship Results –The Junior East/West Championships were held on April 2 & 9. 62.0% of the teams participated on April 2 and 69.3% participated on April 9. The Carolina Regional Championships for the top teams from Division 1 of each age group was held on April 16. We had a participation rate of 82.1% for the April 16 Regionals (competing tournaments hurt our participation here).
- e. Inter-Region/National Performances:
 - ➤ JUNIORS We had two teams earn OPEN bids at Qualifiers CJV 17-1 National and Triangle 17 Black; Xcel 18X Select won an 18 American bid at the Big South Qualifier.
- f. Coaching Program:
 - o We held three IMPACT clinics in the Region this season (both Regionsponsored and club-sponsored) certifying 121 coaches. USA Volleyball's On-Demand IMPACT clinic continues to be a convenient option for most of our coaches to get their certifications. Overall 426 Coaches received IMPACT certifications this season (in-person or online).

- g. Officials Program:
 - Online clinics and training for officials is available with access directly from a member's record this season.
 - We certified 7254 (6809 last year) referees through online and in-person clinics this season.
 - o The Officials Accelerated Advancement Program was introduced this season and we had eight officials register to be a part of it. This is a three-year program with the goal of advancing each official's skills with more focused training. It was a great success in its inaugural season.
- h. Summary The Carolina Region continued its recent membership surge over the past several seasons and surpassed 10,000 total members for the first time. We have made several changes to formats and scheduling in order to accommodate the new teams and members. These have been accepted well and we continue to hear positive feedback on many of our programs.
 - B. National State of the Game Fred Wendelboe:
 - Doug Beal is retiring at the end of the year. A search is going on now for his replacement.
 - There are a lot of other Senior Staff that are aging so there may be a lot of staff turnover in the next few years.
 - The Beach Department opened a new training facility and had a reception there in January. The beach athletes are getting along a lot better with USAV now.
 - This year's US Open Championships is in Orlando and they have already announced a record number of teams participating. The Carolina Region will have four teams competing.
