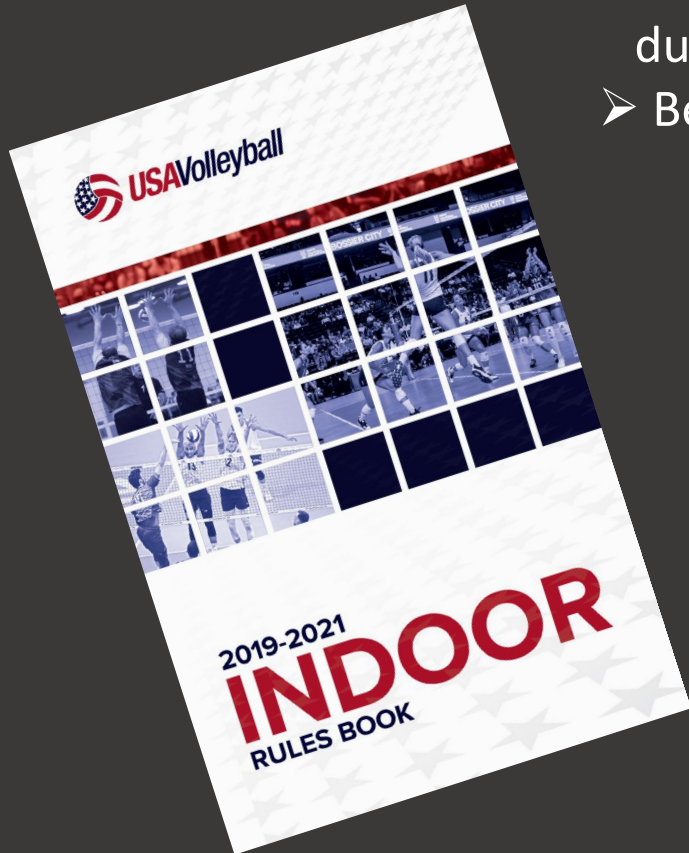

What are the Requirements?

- Attend in-person training
 - Dec 1 – Raleigh
 - Dec 15 - Greensboro
- Prior Knowledge of Rules and Scorekeeping
- Prior experience as a First Referee (working as your teams' First Referee during pool play)
- Be evaluated at a junior's tournament.

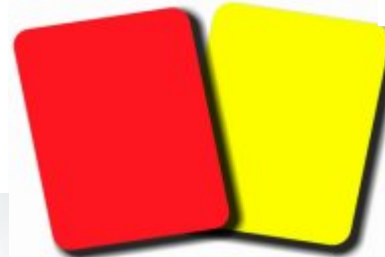

What is the cost?

- Shirts - \$32.95/\$36.95
- Slacks - \$30
- Shoes - \$60
- Starter kit - \$45
- Linesman Flags - \$16-\$40
- Watch - \$20



A Day In The Life

- Tournament Format
 - Most Common - 4 team pools
 - 6 matches of pool play
 - Semifinals/finals
 - 3 team, 5 team, 6 team pools
 - Tournament Director
- 3 for 2
 - Use 3 referees for every 2 courts
 - At most will work 2 matches, then off 1
- Arrive 8am
 - Sign in on the CR Officials Pay Report form
 - Coaches meeting 8:30
 - Play starts 9:00
- Mandatory lunch break for most formats
 - 30 minutes after 3rd match



A Day In The Life

- Pool Play
 - Manage court
 - Utilize Head Referee
 - 13s & under
 - R1 for match
 - Coach may request an experienced junior player to be R1 in second set only
 - Conduct coin toss
 - Get warm-ups started
 - Assist work team
 - R1, R2, Scorer, LJs
- Play-offs
- Sign out on the CR Officials Pay Report form – **required to get paid**



1st Tournament Evaluation Process

- Will be assigned to a site with raters/trainers
- You will work at least one match as
 - R1/R2
 - Scorer
 - Court manager
- If the raters/trainers feel that you are capable in all aspects
 - It may take up to two tournaments to get all requirements completed.

Junior Regional Official

- Once you become a Junior Regional Official, you will be invited to join our ArbiterSports group
- ArbiterSports
 - Used to assign officials to tournaments
 - ArbiterPay
 - Used for officials' payments
 - Linked to ArbiterSports
 - Year-end 1099
- Payment Information
 - Made within 3 weeks of the event
 - TDs have 2 weeks to submit post-tournament materials
 - Payments are usually made within 2 days of receipt of that material
