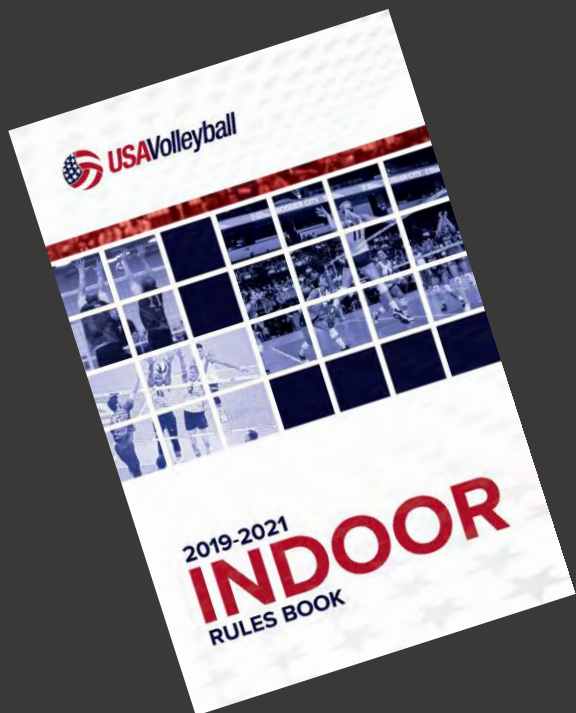

A Day In The Life (typical)

- Tournament Format
 - Most Common - 4 team pools
 - 6 matches of pool play
 - Semifinals/finals
 - 3 team, 5 team, 6 team pools
 - Tournament Director
- 3 for 2
 - Use 3 referees for every 2 courts
 - At most will work 2 matches, then off 1
- Arrive 8am
 - Sign in on the CR Officials Pay Report form
 - Coaches meeting 8:30
 - Play starts 9:00
- Mandatory lunch break for most formats
 - 30 minutes after 3rd match





A Day In The Life

- Pool Play
 - Manage court
 - Utilize Head Referee
 - 13s & under
 - R1 for match
 - Coach may request an interested junior player to be R1 in second set only
 - Conduct coin toss
 - Get warm-ups started
 - Assist work team
 - R1, R2, Scorer, LJs
- Play-offs
- Sign out on the CR Officials Pay Report form – **required to get paid**



1st Tournament Evaluation Process

- Will be assigned to a site with raters/trainers
- You will work at least one match as
 - R1 and R2
 - Scorer
 - Court manager
- If the raters/trainers feel that you are capable in all aspects

Certified Official

- Once you become a certified official, you will be invited to join our ArbiterSports group
- ArbiterSports
 - Used for officials' tournament assignments
 - ArbiterPay
 - Used for official's payments
 - Linked to ArbiterSports
 - Year-end 1099
- Payment Information
 - Made within 3 weeks of the event
 - TDs have 2 weeks to submit post-tournament materials
 - Payments are usually made within 2 days of receipt of that material

Life as the 1st Referee

What are the Responsibilities of an R1?





Pre-Match

- ❖ Event Management
- ❖ Equipment Check
- ❖ Playable Areas
- ❖ Measure Net
- ❖ Converse with the Line Judges
- ❖ Captain's Meeting
- ❖ Observe Warm-Ups

During Play

- ❖ Eye focus
 - Ball handling – see each contact by getting eyes ahead of the ball to the contact point with the player's body part
- ❖ Back Row awareness
 - What player is where on the court
- ❖ End of rally
 - Sharp blast immediately when fault occurs
 - Signal sequence





In Between Rallies

- ❖ Scan, Scan and Scan
 - Game interruptions – subs, time-outs
 - Is the coach upset at the call?
- ❖ Court Management
 - Reset where the players are
 - Libero exchanges
 - All participants ready?
- ❖ Assistance to R2 (if otherwise occupied)
 - Stop unauthorized substitutions
 - Time-outs





Mechanics and Techniques





Starting The Rally

- ❖ Pre-Serve Scan
 - Receiving side first incorporating the LJ, the 6 players, the bench, the coach
 - Our Partners across the court including the table
 - The serving team's side incorporating players and coach along with the LJ
 - Finally make eye contact with the server
- ❖ Beckon
 - Whistle (sharp blast) and then extend arm and pull hand across to opposite shoulder



In-match Duties

- ❖ Ball Handling
 - Illegal contacts
 - Multiple contacts (2nd or 3rd contact)
 - 4-Hits
 - Simultaneous

Ball handling is the primary responsibility of the R1. The R1 is responsible for watching every contact and rendering a judgment about the legality of that contact. To best accomplish this, the R1 must have his/her eyes focused at the point of contact prior to the ball arriving.





In-match Duties

- ❖ Illegal Block & Illegal Attacks
 - Horizontal plane of the net vs. the vertical plane of the net
 - Position of the ball & players relative to these two planes

Illegal blocks are determined by position(s) of the players and the position of their hands

Illegal attacks are determined by the position of the player's feet and the position of the ball





In-match Duties

- ❖ Attack: All actions which direct the ball toward the opponents (except service and block) are considered attack hits
- ❖ Block: Blocking is the action of players close to the net to intercept the ball coming from the opponent by reaching higher than the top of the net, regardless of the height of the ball contact.





In-match Duties

❖ Libero Exchange

- May enter/exit the court with no intervention by the R2
- Whom do they replace and who replaces them

❖ Libero Actions

- Restricted in certain offensive playing actions such as overhead sets and attack hits
- Serving





Summary

- ❖ In and Out are relatively easy. Where you will earn your money as the 1st referee is consistency of ball handling and determining the legality of plays involving back row players and the libero.
- ❖ Avoid the bobblehead effect. In other words, your eyes and head should not be following the ball into the air
- ❖ See and judge each and every contact

Pre-Match



- ❖ Court Management
- ❖ Interaction with the Score Table
- ❖ Rosters
- ❖ Monitor Warm-Ups
- ❖ Receive and check lineups from coaches
- ❖ Entering the lineups
- ❖ Starting line-up check
- ❖ Everyone ready?



During Play



- ❖ Watch the match
- ❖ Progressions
 - Touches, Net Faults, Centerline
 - Play at net clear, now transition
- ❖ R1 Help
 - 4-hits, Touches, Back Row Players, Interruptions (ball on court, injury)
 - Ball-handling only on what is discussed in pre-match
- ❖ End of rally
 - Move to fault side and mirror the signals of R1





In Between Rallies

- ❖ Scan, Scan and Scan Again
 - Game interruptions – Subs, Time-outs, Scoreboard
 - Does the coach have a question
- ❖ Court Management
 - Monitor the players (tying shoe, chasing ball)
 - Libero exchange

- ❖ Indicate Player
- ❖ Mimic R1 Award of Rally





Techniques – R1 Whistle

- ❖ Transition to fault side
- Use same transition movement
- ❖ Mimic the R1
- Calm & deliberate signal sequence
- Telling a story





Transition – The Dance





Transition – The Dance

- ❖ How do we start each point?
- ❖ When do we do our initial transition?
- ❖ How & when do we move during the play?
- ❖ Where should I be at the end of the play?





Transition – The Dance

- ❖ To start each play, we need to be on the receiving team's side of the court and slightly open to the receive court watching for positional faults
- ❖ At contact of serve, we start our DANCE as we move to the blocker's side of the court
- ❖ Once we are on the blocker's side of the court, we should be slightly angled and opened up to the far court, watching the play develop through the net



Transition – The Dance

❖ As the play comes to the net, we need to narrow our focus and do our job as R2

❖ Go through your progressions

➤ Touches

➤ Net Faults

➤ Centerline





Transition – The Dance

- ❖ After we have gone through our progressions and no faults have occurred, it is time to MOVE!
- ❖ Transition with a purpose.
- ❖ As with the initial transition, once you get to the blocker's side, you want to be slightly angled through the net towards the other side and watch the play develop
- ❖ Once the play has finished, transition to the fault side and mirror the R1 signal sequence





Transition – The Dance

- ❖ After we transition to the blocker's side, we want to find our "Sweet Spot"
- ❖ This is the spot where we feel, without any further movement, We can see 99% of all the plays and perform all duties from
- ❖ On OCCASION, a play develops that needs to be looked at differently and we now need to move to a secondary position
- ❖ On OCCASION, a play develops that requires us to stay, even if it is on the attacker's side.



Summary



- ❖ Transition is the movement from side to side before, during and after the play
- ❖ It's 2 or 3 Steps - - not a waltz or disco
- ❖ Remember our duties as R2
